

Photography & Filming

This information applies to all players, parents, spectators, officials and visitors at MENA competitions.



PARENTS & SPECTATORS

- Personal photography allowed focusing on your own child or team
 - Club photographers who have registered & wearing visible ID. Notify coaches, team managers & umpires.
 - MENA may appoint photographers for promotional or training purposes.
- ⚠ If any player has a media exemption, no photography or filming is permitted during that game.



NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME

- Live streaming
- Photos/videos in toilets or change rooms
- Photos of team lists
- Photography of children with a media exemption
- Filming at training unless directed by the coach
- Photography of umpires or MENA staff



EXEMPTIONS

Exemptions may be granted in special circumstances.

REPORTING CONCERNS
